



Harry Gilbert David Obituary

March 11, 1961 - October 5, 2005

Harry "Gil" David, 44, of Albany died Wednesday at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital due to a motorcycle accident. A casual dress, memorial service to celebrate the life of Gil David will be held 2PM, Monday, October 10, 2005, at Kimbrell-Stern Funeral Directors. A native of Dublin GA and a graduate of Dublin High School class of 79, Gil had lived in the Albany area for the past 17 years. He was the owner of Asylum Professional Body Art, and was a motorcycle builder, mechanic, and special event coordinator for Hog Wild Motorcycles. Survivors include his wife, Julie Boggs David of Albany, 2 sons; Joey David, and Brandon David of Albany, a daughter, Jordan Heather David, of Albany, his mother, Virginia Miller David Simpson, of Dothan AL, a brother, Britt David of Sandersville, GA, a sister Pennie David Oates of Dothan, AL, mother-in-law and father-in-law, Mollie and Joe Boggs Sr. of Leesburg, and a brother-in-law, Joe Boggs Jr. of Albany. He was preceded in death by his father Charles Jordan David. There will be a bike ride starting from Hog Wild Motorcycles at 1 PM Monday October 10, 2005 and ending at Kimbrell-Stern by 2 PM to attend the memorial celebration of life service for Gil David. You immediately won the hearts of my sons and my mom and dad. I remember when I would have to work on Saturdays at the apartment complex where we both lived and Brandon would have to sit in the office with me all day and he would stare at that pool. You spent a lot of time on Saturdays at that pool and we would talk a lot and that's where I friendship started. You began to come in the office and get Brandon to take him outside to the pool. You would play with him the whole time tossing him in the water and swimming with him on your back. Brandon would look forward to those Saturdays all week long. There had never been a man in his life. I remember how bad Brandon and Joey would fight. I would be losing my mind with all the fighting but you would always have a special way to remedy the situation and both boys would be happy with the decision made. Even at that young age both of the boys looked up to you and trusted you. Because of you I was able to go back to school after we were married and Jordan had been born.
