Harvey Jackson Pate, Jr., 73, of Albany, died Monday, August 12, 2024 at Piedmont Hospital in Atlanta.

His funeral service will be at 2 PM on Saturday, August 17, 2024 at Central Baptist Church with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. The Rev. Doug Eason and the Rev. Trey Pate will officiate. The family will receive friends prior to the service on Saturday at Central Baptist Church beginning at 1 PM.

Harvey was born in Albany and graduated from Albany High School in 1969. He was a graduate of Albany Junior College and the University of Georgia. Harvey attended and was actively involved at Central Baptist Church. During his career, he was employed with ACC Food Distributors Inc., Albany Tractor, and D&D Wood Preserving.

Harvey was an avid outdoorsman who spent as many days as he could hunting and fishing. As

much as he enjoyed time in the solitude of the woods, he found more joy in sharing his love and knowledge of the outdoors with others. This love of nature also came to life in his artistry.

Harvey enjoyed creating wildlife art, spending many hours carving ducks, painting, and creating pen and ink sketches of scenes native to Southwest Georgia.

Harvey was known to always have a book in his hand and for his encyclopedic knowledge on a wide range of topics that he was more than happy to share with others.

Through the years,

Harvey threw thousands of balls between batting practices for a generation of little league

baseball players and for his much-loved dogs, the most recent of which is his best girl, Jacey.

Harvey was preceded in death by his parents, Harvey Jackson Pate and Allie Malone Pate.
