Helene S. Lutz, 84, of Albany, died Monday April 11, 2005 at Morningside of Albany. Her funeral service will be FRIDAY 11 AM at Kimbrell-Stern with interment to follow at Riverside Cemetery. David Stern will officiate. Helene Lutz was born in Ligonier, Indiana and was educated in the Ligonier schools. She graduated from Woodrow Wilson Jr. College in Chicago. She met and married Harry Lutz during the war and came to Albany in 1946 after the war. She was a member of Temple B'Nai Israel, past president of the Temple Sisterhood, past president of the Hebrew Ladies Benevolent Society, and a member of the Albany Women's Club. She was named Homemaker of the Year in Albany in 1964. She was preceded in death by her husband Harry Lutz. Survivors include 2 sons: Harry S. Lutz, of Atlanta and Sam Lutz of Leesburg; a daughter: Marilyn Dodd of Oklahoma, a sister: Dorothy Newman, Indianapolis, IN; 16 grandchildren.
