Mr. Henderson C. "Hennie" Walden, 87, of Albany, died Saturday, June 8, 2013 at his home.

He will have a private memorial service.

Mr. Walden was born in Albany, GA, and lived here all his life, except for the time he spent in the military. He began working with the U. S. Postal Service in 1942, working before and after school for two years until he graduated from Albany High School with the Class of 1944. Mr. Walden had a forty-one year career with the Postal Service, advancing to management the last twelve years. He served as the Acting Post Master of Dawson, GA. Mr. Walden was a Charter Member of Covenant Presbyterian Church. He was a member of the Walter Burt American Legion Post 30 for over 61 years. He enjoyed yearly trips to the Montezuma peach orchards and sharing peaches with family and friends. He was preceded in death by his wife, Clara Morgan Walden, his parents, John A. and Ida Poe Walden, Sr., his sisters, Frances Summerford, Agnes Milam, Louise Jacks, and Johnnie Walden, his brothers, Frank Walden and John A. Walden, Jr., and his beloved pet cat John Henry.

Mr. Walden is survived by his son: Alfred Cleve Walden; a daughter: Beth Melody Walden Price and her husband Jim, all of Albany.
