Henry O'Neal Lancaster, 78, of Savannah, formerly of Albany, died Friday, October 12, 2007, in Savannah, GA. His funeral service will be MONDAY 1 PM at Kimbrell-Stern with entombment to follow at Crown Hill Mausoleum with military honors. A native of Pickens County, AL, Mr. Lancaster moved to Lee County in 1969 following his retirement from the US Air Force with 22 years of service and the rank of Senior Master Sergeant. He worked with Bill Chambers Motors after his retirement from the Air Force for 33 years, retiring from there in 2002. Mr. Lancaster moved to Savannah in 2006.
