Henry Horton Page, 84, of Albany, GA died at his home surrounded by his family on July 3, 2018 after a brief illness.

Henry was born August 23, 1933 in Columbus, GA, the son of Sarah Margaret Brown and Newell Henry Page. He attended schools in Columbus and graduated in 1951 from Columbus High School. Upon graduation he attended Alabama Polytechnic Institute, Auburn, AL where he was a member of Sigma Alpha Epsilon fraternity before joining the United States Army in 1953, where he served for 2 years in Goosebay, Labrador and Ft. Benning, GA before resuming his studies at the University of Georgia.

On September 6, 1958 He was married to Patricia Neal of Columbus and was employed by Bickerstaff Clay Products of Phenix City, AL for 20 years where he eventually became a plant manager before moving to Albany, GA in 1978 to go into the tire business with his brother-in-law, Clark Neal, at Albany General Tire Service. Henry loved the outdoors and spent many hours hunting and fishing. He was a former member and past president of the Albany Kiwanis Club. He also was a charter member of Christ United Methodist Church where he served in many different capacities and was involved in their missions program making several trips to Mexico and Costa Rica. He was a devoted husband, father, and grandfather, a faithful worker and a loyal friend to all who knew him.

Survivors include his wife of 60 years, Patricia, and four sons, Henry H.
