Mr. Henry T. Wright 84, of 2004 Nelms Rd. in Albany died February 14, 2007 at Palmyra Medical Center. A native of Hart Co., GA, Mr. Wright has lived in Albany since 1952 and attended Liberty Hill Baptist Church in Worth County. Mr. Wright served in the United States Army Air Corp. during World War II; he was a member of the Albany Elks Lodge # 713 for 28 years serving as Lodge Trustee from 1991-1996, Corporation Trustee and served on various other committees within the lodge. He worked from 1952-1968 at John Deere & Company, from 1968-1987 (retired), he was co-owner and manager of Albany Tractor Co. and served as a Director for numerous state and local farm and farm equipment organizations. Mr. Wright was currently serving as a Director of the Dougherty County Farm Bureau and from 1951-present Mr. Wright actively farmed. Mr. Wright was a devoted and loving husband and father.
