



Herb Blackwell Obituary

Herb Blackwell, 75, of Albany, died Monday, September 26, 2005 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital. Mr. Blackwell's memorial service will be held TUESDAY, OCTOBER 4, 2005 at 6 PM at Northgate Presbyterian Church. The Rev. Richard O. Smith, Jr. will officiate. His remains will be cremated. A native of Trenton, NJ, Mr. Blackwell came to Albany in 1959 when he was stationed at Turner AFB. He remained in Albany and was employed with the Albany Fire Department, retiring in 1985. Mr. Blackwell moved to Tifton in 1987, living there until returning to Albany in 1999. He was a member of Northgate Presbyterian Church, the American Legion, Georgia State Retired Firefighters Association, and the Moose Lodge. Survivors include his wife: Helen V.
