



## Mr. Herbert Grodemange

June 24, 1930 - March 1, 2016

Herb Grodemange, 85, formerly of Albany, died Tuesday March 1, 2016 at Emory University Hospital.

The funeral service will be held Monday March 7, 11 AM at Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. Rev. Leigh Ann Raynor and Rev. William Collins will officiate.

A native of Ocean Springs, Miss., Mr. Grodemange lived in Albany for several years. He was an engineer with Proctor & Gamble retiring with over 40 years of service and served in the U. S. Army during the Korean Conflict. He was a member of Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church and the Alpha Sunday School Class. Mr. Grodemange was active in many areas of the Albany community including being the Volunteer of the Year of the YMCA and Albany, Past President of Goodwill, Habitat for Humanity through Porterfield, YMCA Property Committee, Board member with the Girls, Inc. and member of Doublegate Country Club. He was preceded in death by his wife Deloras Vaughan Grodemange and a son Bob Grodemange.
