



## Howard Jackson Smith Obituary

Howard Jackson Smith, 73, passed away Tuesday, March 18, 2014 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital. Funeral services will be Friday at 11:00 AM at Kimbrell-Stern, Albany, Georgia. Tony Haefs will be officiating. Visitation will be at the funeral home one hour before the service. There will be a private burial at Crown Hill Cemetery for the family.
