



Huey Harris Sellers Obituary

January 16, 1924 - August 6, 2006

A native of Wisner LA, Mr. Sellers has lived in Albany since 1965. He was a member of the United States Navy serving his country during WWII, seeing duty during the Pacific Theatre. Upon being honorably discharged in 1946, he returned to Central FL to work for an uncle, Will Sellers in the family Department Store, and later became a tile contractor. He came to Albany in 1965 and with the assistance of his nephew, Glenn Denmark they started D&S Tile. Later the name was changed to Sellers Tile. He retired in 1968. He was of the Baptist faith but attended Covenant Presbyterian. He was a member of the VFW, and the American Legion. He had a great love for life, gardening, fishing, animals and all sports, especially the Atlanta Braves and the Georgia Bulldogs. He was preceded in death by his parents Andrew McNeil and Mattie Harper Sellers, a twin sister Ruey Sellers and 2 brothers: Alvin and Cecil Sellers and a sister Vera Sellers. He is survived by his wife of 59 years, Norma Chisholm Sellers; a son Larry Sellers and his wife Letty; 2 daughters: Dianne Sellers, and Kathy E. Sellers all of Albany; a granddaughter Llewelyn Brillantes Sellers of Athens; a brother James Bradley Sellers of Bartow FL; 2 sisters: Carolyn Sellers Dupont, and Gloria Sellers Murray both of Rayville LA; and a host of much loved nieces and nephews.
