Hugh E. Allen, 88, of Albany, died Tuesday, July 21, 2015 at his home.

The family will receive friends Thursday, July 23, 2015 from 11-12 PM at Kimbrell-Stern. Mr. Allen was cremated and his cremated remains will be buried at Crown Hill Cemetery at a later date.

Mr. Allen was born in Albany, and he was a graduate of Albany High School in the Class of 1943. Following high school, he enlisted in the U.S. Navy and served during the Korean War. Mr. Allen attended the Kansas City School of Watch Making, then returned to Albany to work with John Ross Jewelers, and then with Savelle Jewelers. In 1979, he joined his son Steve Allen at Allen's Jewelers and worked until he retired in 1987. Mr. Allen was preceded in death by his wife, Margie Carolyn Davis Allen, his parents, Ivey Morris Allen and Rachel Bennett Allen, his brother, Ben, and his sister, Dot.

Mr. Allen is survived by his son: Steve Allen and his wife Joy, Albany; 3 grandsons: Steven Allen, Albany, SPC Bryson Allen, USA, stationed in Kuwait, and 2 LT Seth Allen, USA, Ft. Polk, LA.
