



## Inez H. Layfield Obituary

March 14, 1913 - August 2, 2006

Inez Hughes Layfield, 93, of Albany, died Wednesday, August 2, 2006 at her home. Her funeral service will be FRIDAY (Today), 11 AM at Liberty Parkway Church of God with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. The Rev. Dr. H. W. Rutledge, Jr. and the Rev. W. A. Bingham will officiate. A native of Mitchell County, Mrs. Layfield had lived in Albany since 1928. She was a longtime member of Liberty Parkway Church of God, formerly the Eighth Avenue Church of God, the Crape Myrtle Chapter of the Order of the Eastern Star, and the Ladies Auxiliary of Veterans of Foreign Wars. Mrs. Layfield was employed at Flint River Textiles for over forty years. She was preceded in death by her first husband, Robert W. Hughes, her second husband, Ernest I. Layfield, her son, Whaley Hughes and his wife Shirley, and 2 grandchildren, Wesley Hughes and Johnny Paul King, and a great-great grandchild, Shannon Bowden. Her surviving family include a son: Billy Hughes and his wife Hazel, Albany; a daughter: Grace King, Albany; a sister: Hazel Hambric, Albany; 12 grandchildren; 25 great grandchildren; 8 great-great grandchildren; 2 great-great-great grandchildren. Mrs. Hughes' casket will be placed at Liberty Parkway Church of God at 10 AM, and the family will receive friends there
