The family will receive friends Wednesday from 5 to 7 PM at Kimbrell-Stern. A native of Albany, Mr. Farmer was the owner and operator of Tri-State Sales Company until his retirement in 1990. He was a life long resident of Albany and graduated from Albany High School in 1942. Mr. Farmer enlisted in the Air Force in April 1943 and served as a Flight Engineer in the Air Transportation Command until March 1946. Mr. Farmer graduated from Emory Junior College in June 1948 and attended Emory University until August 1949. His sales career began in 1949 with Proctor and Gamble. In 1951 Lloyd became a sales representative with Tri-States Sales Company of Albany. Through his career with Tri-State he served as Sales Manager and Vice President and later President. He was a member of American Legion Post #30 since 1946, American Numismatic Association since 1967 and was a member of First United Methodist Church. He was preceded in death by his parents Howard and Clarice Manry Farmer and a sister Gladys. Survivors include his wife Priscilla W. Farmer; son, Howard Keaton Farmer; daughters, Melanie Batchelor and her husband Bill, Sonya F. Usry and her husband Jerry; brother, Col. H. L.
