



Jack E. Bradshaw Obituary

June 11, 1932 - February 24, 2010

He was born June 11, 1932 in Thomaston, GA, and resided in Albany since 1952. He moved to Albany after his service in the 14th Cavalry APO 46 stationed in Germany during the Korean War. He received an Occupational Medal during his tour of duty. The Army of Occupation Medal was given to those who served in the occupied territories of former enemies from 1945 to 1955. Upon moving to Albany, he worked at the Flint River Cotton Mill until 1955 when he went to work at the Marine Logistics Base in Albany, GA until his retirement in 1987. Until recently, he worked part-time for Mauldin and Jenkins in Albany. Mr. Bradshaw was always active with the youth of Albany as a little league coach, midget football coach and served as a coach for Riverview Academy. He was a referee and umpire for many years. An avid square dancer, he was a member of the Rafters Rockers Square Dance Club. In his spare time, he enjoyed hunting and fishing. He was a long-time member of Palmyra Road Methodist Church in Albany where he served on the Board of Trustees; was President of the Men's Club and served on the Church council. Survivors include his wife, Sadye Jo Whitley Bradshaw; three children, Bonnie Bradshaw Clark (Mike), Bill Bradshaw (Shay) and Luann Bradshaw Bloodworth (Bob); grandchildren, Heather Lynn Spence (Mike), Brian Bradshaw, Kelley Bradshaw, Jake Clark, Franklin Bradshaw, Emily Bradshaw and Will Bloodworth; two great grandchildren, Jocelynn Spence and Brooklynn Spence. He is also survived by a sister, Geraldine Sexton and several nieces and nephews.
