Jack W. Bryant, 87, of Lake Blackshear, died Sunday, April 12, 2015 at his home.

His funeral service will be at 2 PM on Tuesday, April 14, 2015 at Kimbrell-Stern with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. The Rev. Phil Streetman and the Rev. Charlie Brown will officiate. The family will receive friends at Kimbrell-Stern on Monday (Today) from 6-8 PM.

Mr. Bryant was born in Richland, GA, and was a long-time resident of Albany before moving to Lake Blackshear 8 years ago. He is a member of Lake Blackshear Baptist Church, and was a former member of Byne Memorial Baptist Church. Mr. Bryant was a veteran of the Korean War and served in the Intelligence Corps. He was employed with Hav-A-Tampa Cigars, Cannon Amusement Co., and with Adams Exterminators. He was a member of the Exchange Club of Albany for over 40 years, and was also a member of the Walter H. Burt American Legion Post 30. Mr. Bryant was preceded in death by his brother, Walter C. Bryant.
