Jack Futch, 90, of Leesburg, GA, died Tuesday, November 5, 2019 at his home.

His funeral service will be at 2 PM on Saturday, November 9, 2019 at Kimbrell-Stern with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. The Rev. Bruce English will officiate. The family will receive friends prior to the service on Saturday at Kimbrell-Stern beginning at 1 PM until the funeral hour.

Mr. Futch was born in Thomasville, GA, and had lived in Albany for many years. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Albany and the Winsome Sunday School Class. He was an Air Force Veteran. Mr. Futch was a mason and a member of the Hasan Shrine. He retired from Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital and was widely known as “Key Man” from his years cutting keys at Kitty’s Flea Market.
