



## Jack Earl Hall Obituary

November 1, 1919 - February 7, 2006

Jack Earl Hall, 86, of Albany, died Tuesday, February 7, 2006 at his residence in Albany. The funeral service will be held at 11 AM Friday at Byne Memorial Baptist Church with interment to follow in Crown Hill Cemetery. Dr. William H. Simms, III officiating. A native of Ambrose, GA, Mr. Hall served in the Army Air Corp during WWII and was stationed here in Albany at Turner Field. He was a champion diver and won several medals in swimming. He retired in 1980 from John Blue Equipment Company where he worked as the parts manager. Mr. Hall was a volunteer with the Board of Elections as a poll worker. He also served as a volunteer with The Lord's Pantry and with the Meals on Wheels program. Mr. Hall was a member of Byne Memorial Baptist Church for 58 years, the Brothers in Christ Sunday School Class and he served as the secretary of Beginners Children's Sunday School Class for 30 years. Mr. Hall was preceded in death by his twin brother, Mearl Hall; a sister, Vivian Dixon; and an older brother Norman Hall. Mr. Hall is survived by his loving wife, Velma Hall of Albany; a daughter, Gail Mann and her husband Raleigh of Macon; a son, Tony Hall and his wife Angie of Carrollton; four grandchildren: Ashlee Ligarde and her husband Jeff, MiAnne Mann, Jason Hall and Wyn Hall; two sisters: Helen Carter and her husband Phil of Acree, and Mary Sheffield of Blakely; and his favorite pet, Smokey. The family will receive friends at Byne Memorial Baptist Church on Friday morning from 10 AM until the funeral hour.
