



Jack H. Hesse Obituary

April 7, 1925 - January 17, 2005

Jack Hesse, 79, of Albany, died Monday, January 17, 2005 at Albany Health Care following an illness. His funeral service will be FRIDAY 10 AM at St. Teresa's Catholic Church with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. The Revs. Jim Bok, ofm, Herbert J. Wellmeier, and Finbarr Stanton will officiate. A native of Cincinnati, OH, Mr. Hesse had lived in Albany for 30 years. He graduated from Reading High School where he excelled in athletics, earning all state honors in football, basketball, and baseball. He was inducted into the Reading High School Hall of Fame in 1987. Mr. Hesse was a Navy veteran of WWII, serving from 1943 to 1946. Following the war, he played minor league baseball in the Cincinnati Reds organization and in the Washington Senators organization. He was employed with and retired from the McGregor Golf Co. in 1990. Following his retirement, he was a member of Radium Country Club. Mr. Hesse was a member of St. Teresa's Catholic Church, the Knights of Columbus, the Walter Burt American Legion Post 30, and the Albany YMCA. Survivors include his wife of 58 years, Rosemary Hesse, Albany; 4 daughters: Patti Hall and her husband David, Gulf Shores, AL, Barbara Coyle and her husband John, Cincinnati, OH, Karen Schafer and her husband Mark, Chicago, IL, Jackie Martin and her husband Keith, Leesburg; 7 grandchildren: Seth, Kate, and Liz Coyle; Molly and Luke Schafer, Clay and Ryan Martin. The Rosary service will be recited at Kimbrell-Stern on Thursday at 7 PM with visitation to follow till 8:30 PM.
