



## Jack M. Ledbetter Obituary

December 8, 1922 - March 29, 2004

A native of Camilla, Ledbetter was a World War II veteran serving in the 83rd Army Infantry Division. He attended Mercer University and the University of Georgia where he studied horticulture. He was retired from Albany Coca-Cola Bottling Co. where he was marketing manager for 29 years. He was a member of First United Methodist Church and was preceded in death by his wife Jane Haley Ledbetter. Ledbetter turned his college education into a beloved hobby, landscape design and management, which he shared with family and dear friends. He will be especially remembered for his quick wit and keen sense of humor which he inherited from his father, the late James Drewry Ledbetter, Sr. His parents owned and operated the McNair Hotel in Camilla where he, family members and friends congregated daily for many years. He often reminisced with great humor about those particular memories. "And it's a true story," he would note laughingly.
