



Jack C. White Obituary

October 16, 1947 - August 17, 2004

Jack, the son of Jack Cecil White, Sr. and Juanita Swindle White grew up in Albany where he graduated from Albany High School. He then attended the University of Georgia where he earned a Bachelor's and Master's degree in Sociology / Criminology. He taught Sociology at Jacksonville State University in Jacksonville, Alabama for three years, and then managed a Delinquent Group Home in Birmingham, Alabama for two years. He then returned to Albany where he worked for Dougherty County Family & Children Services in child abuse and custody, for seven years. He was accidentally burned in 1986 and received extensive reconstruction surgery at Crawford Long Hospital in Atlanta. In spite of the burns and disabilities he continued his life long membership at the Albany YMCA, winning many trophies in tennis and racquet ball. Jack is a charter member of Central Baptist Church.
