He retired from Sears in the Auto Service Center with more than 35 years of employment. He was preceded in death by his parents, Benjamin F. and Hilda Jones Blow and his sister Elizabeth Blow Whitfield. He is survived by his wife of 55 years, Sarah Hall Blow of Sylvester, and a host of nieces, nephews and good friends.
