James Allen Cain, Sr. died Tuesday, October 7, 2014 at Morningside Assisted Living. Funeral services will be held Friday, October 10, 2014 at 11:00 AM at Kimbrell-Stern. Visitation will be held an hour prior to the service. Rev Tom Pollock will officiate with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery.

A native of Webster County, Mr. Cain had lived in Albany most of his life where he was a self employed businessman. He served in the US Army during WWII as well as the European Theatre from 1941-1945. Allen was a member of Sherwood Baptist Church and had a strong faith and love for his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. He dearly loved his wife, children and grandchildren and his family loved him as much. Mr. Cain will be greatly missed by all who knew him.

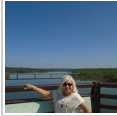
