James C. Kirk, 90, of Albany, died Tuesday, September 21, 2021 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital.

The visitation and funeral service will be held Monday, September 27, 2021 at Kimbrell-Stern Funeral Directors beginning at 1 pm with the service at 2 PM. Interment will follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. Rev. Butch Knight will officiate.

A native of Heard County, Georgia, Mr. Kirk was born to the late Leon and Willie Kirk. He was a member of First Baptist Church where he served as a deacon since 1964. Mr. Kirk also served as a Sunday School teacher for thirty years and a Training Union leader for five years. He was a member of the National Association of Federal Retired Employees, Golden Key Club, AARP and was an Experiencing God Facilitator. Mr. Kirk served in the U.S. Army where he served during the Korean Conflict between 1951 and 1954. He received his BS from ABAC and his MS degree in AG Economics from UGA.
