



## James Edgar Knox Obituary

James (Jim) Edgar Knox, II loving husband, father, grandfather and friend died on Friday January 16, 2009. Survivors include his wife of 54 years, Winifred (Boozie) Moore Knox of Albany, and his children all of Atlanta; Ed Knox and his wife Julie; Sally Knox and Gail Turner and her husband Lawrence. He leaves three beloved grandchildren, Leah Knox, Capt. (USMC) Casey Turner and his wife Lindy and Jordan Walker and her husband Jarrod. Mr. Knox, born on November 11, 1924 was a native of Pontotoc, Mississippi and predeceased by his brother Robert Knox and sister Anne K. Dobbins. During World War II, Mr. Knox was a Radioman Second Class on Patrol Craft #597 in the Pacific Theatre and faithfully served there for three years until the war ended. Following his honorable discharge from the Navy, he attended The University of Mississippi and eventually settled in Albany where he met and married his wife and raised his family. A member of First Baptist Church of Albany since 1949, he taught Sunday School, served as deacon and enjoyed singing in the choir for many years. Mr. Knox was involved in the Kiwanis Club, The Lord's Pantry of First Baptist Church and other charitable endeavors and loved nothing more than being with his family and friends and serving others through lay work. He is greatly missed by all who knew and loved him. Family and friends will be received at Kimbrell-Stern funeral home on Sunday, January 18, 2009 from 3:00 to 5:00PM. The funeral service will be held at 11:15AM on Monday, January 19, 2009 at Kimbrell-Stern Funeral Directors. Interment will follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. The Rev. David Hall
