



James W. Nesbitt, Jr. Obituary

July 24, 1928 - July 8, 2009

Born in Albany on July 28, 1928, Mr. Nesbitt was retired from Giles Builders Supply serving as the President. He was a member of Central Baptist Church where he was a deacon, served on the stewardship committee and a member of the Crusaders Sunday School Class. Mr. Nesbitt attended North Georgia College in Dahlonega and the University of Georgia. He was a Georgia Bulldog enthusiast. He was also an avid outdoorsman, loving fishing and hunting. While attending camp for the Georgia National Guard in 1953, he was stricken with polio with paralytic and bulbar polio. He was in the army hospital for a year before coming home and returning to work part-time. Although he suffered for the remainder of his life with the after effects of polio, Mr. Nesbitt never let it deter his great Christian spirit and his love for his fellow man. Mr. Nesbitt was a member of the Exchange Club of Albany where he was the Exchangite of the Year in 2000. He was a member of American Legion, American Legion Post 30, Disabled American Veterans, Dougherty Lodge #591 F& AM, Scottish Rite and Hasan Temple. He was preceded in death by his parents, James William Nesbitt and Irene Lanier Nesbitt, his brother in law S. Coplin Jarvis, his in laws, Thomas Coplin Jarvis and Stella Sanders Jarvis and a great nephew Jarvis Malone Pate. Survivors include his wife Faye Jarvis Nesbitt, Albany; brother, B. L. Nesbitt and wife Doris, Lee County; nephew, Michael Nesbitt, Kingsland, GA; nieces Carol Nesbitt Bush and husband Vince, Jacksonville, FL, Rhonda Pate and husband Billy, Albany; great nephews, Owen Nesbitt and wife Amanda, Albany, Wesley Bush;
