



## James J. O'Flynn Obituary

January 18, 1942 - December 8, 2010

James F. O'Flynn, 68, of Leesburg, died Wednesday, December 8, 2010 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital. His funeral mass will be 10 AM Monday, December 13, 2010 at St. Teresa's Catholic Church with interment to follow with military honors in Andersonville National Cemetery. Father Stephen Pontzer will officiate. A prayer service will be held at 7 PM Sunday, December 12, 2010 at Kimbrell-Stern with family receiving friends until 9 PM. The family will welcome friends at other times at his residence, 139 Society St., Leesburg, GA. Mr. O'Flynn was a native of Brentwood, NH but was a longtime resident of Albany and Leesburg. Following high school graduation he became a member of the United States Marines, serving as a member of the 3rd Force Recon in Vietnam. Among many awards and recognitions he received the Bronze Star Medal with Combat "V", Purple Heart, Navy Commendation Metal with Combat "V", Combat Action Ribbon, Presidential Unit Citation, Navy Unit Commendation, Meritorious Unit Commendation with one bronze star, Republic of Vietnam Meritorious Unit Citation, and Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal. He served in law enforcement for more than 18 years. He was a loving husband, father, grandfather, son, brother, uncle, and friend to all. He was preceded in death by his mother, Mary Fielders and two sisters. He is survived by his wife, Kathleen Morin O'Flynn of Leesburg, 6 children: Timothy O'Flynn of Albany, Mary O'Flynn Williston (Nate) of Sharpsburg, GA, Patrecia O'Flynn Boutwell (Steve) of Greenfield, NH, Brendan O'Flynn (Maranda) of Leesburg, Bridget O'Flynn Trombley (Gary) of

Albany, and Patrick O'Flynn of Leesburg, 6 grandchildren: Zachary Williston, Kelsey Williston, Ashley Boutwell, Dylan Boutwell, Brayden Trombley, and Aiden O'Flynn, his brother Eugene Fielders of Plymouth NH, his sister Margie Pina (Louis) of Lake Tahoe, CA; several nieces and nephews.
