



## James Garrison Pritchett Obituary

July 16, 1921 - August 5, 2011

James Garrison Pritchett, age 90, died at his residence on Friday, August 5. Born in Alamance County, North Carolina in 1921, Mr. Pritchett graduated from Elon College in 1942, and enlisted in the US Navy, where he served through August 10, 1946. He earned his wings at Whiting Field, near Pensacola, Florida, and became a flight instructor there. Lt. Pritchett served over two years as a pilot in the Pacific theater during WW II, flying R5Ds and other aircraft. After the war, he came to Albany at the suggestion of his uncle, C.B. Pritchett, well-known here as manager of the Haley interests in auto dealerships (Lincoln and Ford). He began his career at Albany Tire and Service, then managed Albany Lincoln-Mercury for ten years. In 1957, he formed his own concern, Pritchett Motors, and sold Edsel, Fiat, Plymouth, Chrysler and Imperial cars. For many years Mr. Pritchett was on the executive board of the Georgia Auto Dealers Association. He was a member of First United Methodist Church and was president and treasurer of the Fellowship Sunday School class. He also served on numerous boards there throughout the years. Mr. Pritchett was a charter member (since 1952) of the Kiwanis Club of Dougherty County. He was Club President, and had perfect attendance for 59 years. He was a past member of the Board of Directors, a Hixon Award recipient, and Special Hixon Award recipient (both indicate a lifetime of achievement and service to the community). He helped start the Little League Youth Baseball program in Albany (now known as Dixie Youth League), and chaired various club committees. He also worked tirelessly on the Pritchett-

Pippin Dance Recital for over 50 years. He was a member of The American Legion for 67 years. He is survived by his wife, Peggy Forehand Pritchett, by two children, Paige Pritchett Samples (Ted), of Cordele, GA, and J. G. "Garry" Pritchett, Jr., of Lawrenceville, GA, by three grandchildren, Chris Samples of Cary, NC, Lowell Samples of Albany, and T.J. Samples (Delaine) of Macon, great grandchildren, as well as many nieces and nephews. Mr. Pritchett has been described as a "quiet influence" by his friends, who were many. He was proud, in a modest way, of being an usher at his beloved church, for over 50 years. Now, he himself has been ushered into the very presence of God, where his friends wish him peace.
