



James E. Sapp, Jr. Obituary

January 5, 1915 - October 23, 2003

Mr. Sapp was born in Albany, GA on January 5, 1915, where he lived with his parents James Everett and Claudia Wall Sapp and brothers Robert and Clarence. He was a graduate of Albany High Class 1931. He received his AB from Duke University in 1935 and his LLB in 1938. Mr. Sapp was admitted to the Georgia Bar in 1938 and to the New York Bar in 1939. Mr. Sapp was married to Ruth Van Cise Sapp in 1940. He was an Associate lawyer with White and Case in New York City from 1938 until 1943, and then with Standard Brands, Inc. in New York City from 1943 until 1971, he served as General Counsel from 1956 until 1971, and Vice President from 1960 until 1971 and as Secretary from 1961 until his retirement in 1971. Mr. Sapp lived in New Jersey from 1949 until 1971, and returned to Albany, GA in 1971 Mr. Sapp served from Private to Captain in the United States Army Air Force from 1943 until 1946 at Wright-Patterson Field in Ohio.
