



## James Stephen "Steve" Hardin

September 17, 1953 - October 4, 2024

Steve Hardin, 71, formerly of Albany, died Friday, October 4, 2024 at his home in Acworth, GA.

Steve's funeral service will be at 1 PM at the graveside at Floral Memory Gardens. The Rev. Andy Hardin will officiate. The family will receive friends at Kimbrell-Stern prior to the service beginning at 12:00 PM. There will be a funeral procession from the funeral home to the cemetery for the service.

Steve was born in Albany and graduated from Albany High School in 1972. Steve excelled in football and baseball. He earned a football scholarship to the University of Southwest Louisiana Ragin' Cajuns, now known as the University of Louisiana Lafayette. After earning his degree, he passed the CPA exam and began his public accounting career with Mauldin and Jenkins. He moved to Destin, FL in 1988 and opened his own accounting practice. He sold his firm in 1998 and moved to Acworth, GA. Steve was a member of the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. He was a member of Crosspoint City Church in Cartersville, GA. Steve was preceded in death by his parents, William Walton Hardin and Doris Sizemore Hardin, his siblings, Billy Hardin, Bob Hardin, and Kay Hardin Lehmann.
