



## James Robert Taylor Obituary

April 15, 1936 - October 6, 2006

Mr. James Robert "Cub" Taylor, 70, of 4919 Gillionville Rd., died Friday, October 6, 2006 at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital. His funeral service will be Monday 2 PM at Christ United Methodist Church. Rev. Kent Miller and Rev. Buford "Beau" Taylor officiating. Born in Cairo, Mr. Taylor had lived in Doerun most of his life, retiring from farming and agriculture interest to move to Albany in 1970 to pursue other business interest.. He attended Brewton-Parker College on a baseball scholarship, played baseball at the University of Ga, and in the United States Air Force as a catcher. He also was a Little League baseball coach in the Doerun area for several years. Mr. Taylor was a member of the Christ United Methodist Church and was active in the Walk to Emmaus reunion group. He was a member of the Not yet Ready for Primetime Players Breakfast Club that meet at Aunt Fannie's on Tuesday, the Doerun Masonic Lodge #151 in Doerun and the River Pointe Golf Club. He was preceded in death by his parents R. J. and Louise Taylor and a son Jimbo Taylor. Survivors include his wife Linda Taylor of Albany; daughters, Cindy Brenden and husband Steve, Athens, Jami Lorentz and her husband Bobby, Ellisville, MS, JoLynn Higdon and her husband Gordy, Gulf Port, MS; son, John Taylor and his wife Jackie, Ellisville, MS; sister Joy Taylor Hatcher and husband Bryant, Lake Seminole; brother Rance J. Taylor, Jr. and his wife Avie, Doerun; 12 grandchildren and 4 great grandchildren. The family will receive friends Sunday 4 to 6 PM at Kimbrell-Stern.
