



James Carl Wigzell Obituary

October 7, 1931 - April 28, 2009

Mr. Wigzell was born October 7, 1931 in Denison, TX, and he graduated from Denison High School in 1949. He attended Arlington State College on a tennis scholarship and left school to join the United States Air Force during the Korean War. While stationed at Turner Field, Mr. Wigzell married the former Viola (Sister) Farkas. Upon completion of his service to his Country, he continued his education at the University of Georgia where he was a member of Phi Epsilon Phi Fraternity. Upon receiving his B.S. Degree in Accounting, he returned to Albany where he resided for 56 years. He was the senior partner of James C. Wigzell CPAs until he retired his accounting practice in 1995. Mr. Wigzell was a member of Temple B'Nai Israel where he had been a religious school teacher and treasurer of the Board of Trustees. He was also an active member of the community serving as President of Goodwill of Albany, Treasurer for Theatre Albany, and a long time Water, Gas, and Light Commissioner. He also served as a member of Public Powers, a national utilities commission. He was preceded in death by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. James C. Wigzell, Denison, TX, and a sister Mrs. Jamesine Abramowitz also of Denison, TX. He is survived by his wife: Viola Wigzell, Albany; his daughters: Nesie Johnson, Jacksonville, FL, Lizanne Clay and her husband Jack, Albany, Georgette Slocumb, West Palm Beach, FL; son: Tramm Wigzell and his wife Katharyn, Los Angeles, CA; his grandchildren: Becky Brown Drake, Kelly Clay, Noah Clay, Christopher Slocumb, Ivie Slocumb, Haz Johnson, and Maggie Wigzell; two great-grandsons: Logan Elder, Scott

Drake, and many beloved nieces and nephews.
