Jane Davidson Goldsmith, of Albany, Georgia, passed away on February 15, 2015.

Her funeral service will be at 2 PM on Wednesday, February 18, 2015 at Kimbrell-Stern with entombment to follow at Crown Hill Mausoleum. Rabbi Dr. Holly Levin Cohn will officiate. The family will receive friends at Kimbrell-Stern on Wednesday from 1:00 PM till 2:00 PM.

She was the widow of the late Dr. Abram O. Goldsmith. She is survived by her two sons, Robert D. Goldsmith and his wife Vicki and Dr. Stuart M. Goldsmith and his wife Kim, her grandchildren, Davidson Goldsmith, Brent Goldsmith, Emma Goldsmith, and Scott Hudler, and her great-grandchildren, Emma Hudler and Matthew Hudler.

Mrs. Goldsmith was born in New Orleans, Louisiana on March 9, 1929, to the late Sara and Dr. Jules Myron Davidson. She attended Vassar College, Newcomb College of Tulane University, and Tulane Medical School. She was a devoted wife and mother and grandmother who treasured these roles. She was a loyal and active member of the Albany community, serving in many contexts with the American Cancer Society, the American Heart Association, the Dougherty County Medical Society, Temple B'Nai Israel, and Theatre Albany.

True to her beloved New Orleans roots, Mrs. Goldsmith loved life and did her best to enjoy every day, and every meal, to the fullest. Her many passions included tennis, golf, jazz, swimming, cooking, traveling, dining, theater and dogs. She was a kind, generous, and thoughtful friend to many. She had a wonderful sense of humor, insatiable curiosity, and undeniable flair. Her radiant smile and effervescent personality will be missed by all who knew her.
