Janeine was a Customer Service Representative with Genie Industries. She loved animals and her favorite dog was Snuffy who died 3 years ago.

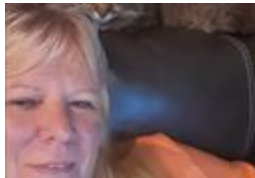
