



Mrs. Janet Van Cise Holaday Obituary

Janet Van Cise Holaday, 95, of Albany, died February 4, 2013 at Willson Hospice House.

She was born in Summit, New Jersey, on October 27, 1917 and moved to Albany, GA in 1919. She graduated from Albany High School in 1934. She continued her art studies at the High Museum of Art in Atlanta.

Janet was the last surviving child of the late William M. and Winifred F. Van Cise of Albany. She was a resident of Albany for the past 48 years.

She was preceded in death by her husbands David Jonathan Westerdahl, Henry Grady Rainey, and siblings Edith Knowles, Peggy Shoemaker, her twin Ruth Sapp, and William Van Cise, Jr.
