Melba Jane "Janie" Smith Barnes, 72, died on May 31, 2012 at her residence in Albany. A memorial service will be held on Sunday June 3, 2012 at 3:00 PM at Kimbrell-Stern with Rev. John Spencer officiating. Visitation will be held on Saturday June 2, 2012 from 6-8 PM at Kimbrell-Stern.

Janie was a resident of Albany, GA. since 1966 and touched the lives of many in this town. Janie worked at the Albany Chamber of Commerce and the Albany Area Arts Counsel during the Bicentennial in 1976. She was known as Zippy Mart Janie during the early 70's and was a proud member of the Albany Red Hat Ladies Society. Janie worked at the Sheraton Inn during the early 80's and finished her career as the Event Coordinator for the Albany Civic Center.
