



## Jeffrey Lynn Miles Obituary

Jeffrey Lynn Miles, 51, of Lee County, died Tuesday, November 29, 2005 at Emory University Hospital in Decatur, GA. The memorial service will be at 2 PM Friday at Leesburg United Methodist Church with Rev. Eugene Barlow and Rev. Russ Elkins officiating. A native of Alabama, he graduated from Valley High School in Valley, AL and following high school, Mr. Miles joined the United States Air Force. He moved to Lee County in 1991. Mr. Miles was a member of Leesburg United Methodist Church. He worked for Fluor Daniel's Construction at Proctor and Gamble and later worked as a tire builder at Cooper Tire. Mr. Miles also worked as a volunteer with the Chehaw BMX Parents Organization. He was preceded in death by his mother, Norma Gray Clark. Mr. Miles is survived by his loving wife, Denise Hall Miles; two daughters: Kacey Miles and Kelli Miles; a son, Tyler Miles, all of Lee County; his father, Herbert E.
