Jessica Ryfun Wilson, 38, died on March 17, 2016 after a four year battle with breast cancer.

Services will be held at First Presbyterian Church in Albany, GA, on Monday, March 21, at 2pm. Jessica requested that no one wear black to her memorial service.

Born on March 10, 1978, in Hinesville, GA, Jessica was raised in Pelham, the youngest of the four daughters of Mike and Betty Ryfun. With both a bachelor's degree in Psychology from Valdosta State University and a nursing degree from Darton State, Jessica worked as a critical care nurse at Palmyra Medical Center before transitioning to quality control at Phoebe Putney Memorial Hospital.

An old soul at heart, Jessica refrained from most modern social media in favor of strong, one-on-one relationships with friends and family. She was genuine to the core, a deeply loyal daughter, friend, wife, and mother who could find the positive in nearly every situation, and always looked at a story from both sides. Even to the end she was an avid reader, a fan of indie music (the quirkiest the better), and a cook whose every fantastic dish was filled with love...and a little butter. Although cancer slowed her down, she fought it for four years and, deep in her heart, always believed she would be healed.

Jessica is survived by her husband, Jon Wilson, and their five-year-old son, Andy; parents Mike and Betty Ryfun; sisters Angie Smith, Amy Shiver, and

Alison Snipes; nieces Kayla and Haley Smith, Emily and Meredith Shiver, Amelia Snipes, and Abbey and Emily Carlton; nephews Gabe Carlton, Parker Smith, and Colin Snipes.
