



## Jevontay Quinzavious Jordan Obituary

March 17, 1992 - September 5, 2011

– U.S. Airman First Class Jevontay Q. Jordan, 19, of Pensacola, FL died on September 5, 2011. He was known as "Bo Jack" by many of his friends and relatives. Funeral services for Mr. Jordan will be Saturday, September 10, 2011 at 4:30 PM at Mt. Zion Baptist Church in Albany, GA. Interment will follow in Crown Hill Cemetery with full Military Honors. Rev. Henry Lee Holsey will officiate. Repast will follow in the church social hall. Visitation will be on Saturday (today) from 9:00 AM until 12:00 PM at Kimbrell-Stern.

Born on March 17, 1992, he was the son of Daphane Jordan and Earl Hooks. He attended Westover High School, where he earned a Varsity Letter in Football. He graduated from the National Guard Youth Challenge Academy at the Ft. Gordon Base in Augusta, GA, where he was a member of the Georgia National Guard Prayer Warrior Club, the Media Club, the Job Shadow Club, as well as the Softball and Basketball teams. He also received the National Fitness Award.

On July 1, 2011, Mr. Jordan graduated Basic Training from Lakeland Air Force Base in San Antonio, TX. He was currently stationed at Moody Air Force Base in Pensacola, FL, where he would have completed his Associates of Applied Science Degree in 2012.

Mr. Jordan was well-loved by many people that knew him. He was a very

loving, caring, and compassionate young man. Mr. Jordan was very talented in the areas of Sports, Literature, and Art .He was well-known for his "made-up" jokes and dances. He had a positive impact on many other young people and had encouraged many of them to join the military. He often left a good impression whenever he associated with older adults.
