First, I saw Jewel just a few weeks ago when I was visiting friends at Phoebe Assisted Living, and she was just as quick at recognizing me as in the years past.

The first time I really got to know Hugh & Jewel was the year Phoebe acquired ownership of Potter Community Center. I was the coordinator of Golden Key. For the Albany Charity Horse Show, Golden Key members were to provide, and sell refreshments during the Horse Show so in our newsletter I asked for volunteers. Your parents and another couple whose names I have forgotten, volunteered for the late afternoon/evening shift. In our booth was a popcorn machine, which they had taught me how to use, but your parents mastered it much better than I. All day long we had not had very many requests for popcorn, so one batch lasted all day until drinks were served in the afternoon/evening portion of the show. Popcorn all of a sudden was in high demand. We could not make it fast enough, but your parents came up with a system to speed up the process so by the end of the day I had deemed your parents the official Popcorn King & Queen of the Golden Key Club. They remain as such in my memories even today!

When I saw your mother I greeted her asking how was my favorite Popcorn Queen, and she just laughed. Hail to the best Popcorn King & Queen ever! They are now together up in heaven maybe even preparing popcorn for all the angels. Thanks for sharing your parents with me.
