



## Jimmie Thackston Clark Obituary

May 16, 1925 - December 3, 2008

Jimmie Thackston Clark died on Wednesday, Dec 3, 2008, at the Life Care Center of Melbourne, Florida. A long-time resident of Indialantic Florida, she was 83. Born in Charlotte, North Carolina, on May 16, 1925, Jimmie moved with her mother, Vivian Thackston, and sister to Albany in the early 1930's, where she lived for 26 years. She was a 1942 graduate of Albany High School and attended Agnes Scott College for Women in Decatur, Ga. Jimmie is the widow of the late Capt Frank C. Newell , USAF of Linden, New Jersey, killed 1951 in an aircraft accident, and the sister of the late, Mrs. Eloise B. Haley, of Albany. Jimmie returned to Albany after the death of her first husband where she lived until she was remarried in 1954, to Capt Roy E. Clark, USAF of Tyler, Texas. Jimmie followed her husband's Air Force career, living in Texas, Nebraska, the United Kingdom and New Hampshire before they retired to Satellite Beach, Florida, in 1969. In 1976 she and her husband returned to Albany residing at 1706 Marbury Lane before relocating to Indialantic, Florida in 1978. In her later years, Jimmie traveled extensively with friends throughout the United States and abroad and was a contributor to the Brevard County Symphony, the Brevard Art Museum and numerous charitable organizations. She enjoyed lifelong friendships with many in Albany and Florida who will miss her. She is survived by her former husband, Roy E. Clark ( Lt. Col ret. USAF) of Tuscaloosa , Alabama, her only son, Mr. Frank C. Newell , and his wife, Maria, of Fairfax, Virginia and two granddaughters , Jamie Buzzetta of Farmville, Virginia, and Meghan Newell of Ashburn, Virginia. A small memorial

service is planned for 1100 am on Dec 29, 2008, at Kimbrell-Stern Funeral Home, 1500 Dawson Road, Albany, Georgia. She was a member of the Methodist Church.
