



Jimmy D. Brooks Obituary

May 16, 1961 - June 3, 2008

Jimmy Dwaine Brooks died Tuesday, June 3, 2008 at his home in Hinsonton, in Mitchell County, Georgia. Jimmy was born on May 16, 1961 in Lawrenceville, Georgia, to George and Sara Brooks. Jim was a long-time police officer, serving with City of Meigs at the time of his death. Jimmy is survived by his mother, Sara A. Warbington of Dahlonega, his sister, Gayle Brooks Miller and her husband, David N. Miller of Sylvester, fianc◆ Sherry Findley Fondren of Albany, brothers Lonnie Brooks of Troupe County, Charles Brooks of Allen, Texas, and George Brooks of Bibb County. He is also survived by a long list of friends from his association with the Albany Moose Lodge, and the Albany HASAN Shriners, and by his best four-footed friend, Dixie. His father and a son preceded him in death. Jimmy's body was cremated, and there will be a memorial service Saturday June 7, at 3:00 at Kimbrell-Stern Chapel, with visitation one hour prior. His ashes will be scattered in the Gulf of Mexico. He was a decorated officer, and was cited for helping save a child's life in Sylvester in 2004. He was seriously injured by a fleeing felon in Cuthbert in 2006, and endured a lengthy rehabilitation. He served with the Fulton County Sheriff's Office, Phillips and Lee State Prisons, and the Stone Mountain Boot Camp, and Sylvester Police department. Jimmy earned a bachelor's degree in criminal justice, and was a dedicated police officer who truly believed in the motto "To protect and to serve." He was a strong advocate of community oriented policing, who took the time to stop and visit with citizens wherever he served, and put a sincere, friendly face on the
