Dr. Joe Greenway 78 of 267 Archie Dr. in Albany died October 18, 2008 at his residence. A native of Treutlen Co., GA Dr. Greenway has lived in Albany since 1933 where he was a 1947 graduate of Albany High School and was Doctor of Chiropractor at Joe Greenway Chiropractor for 47 years. Dr. Greenway was a graduate of Palmer Chiropractic School in Des Moines, IA and Florida State University in 1959. He served in the United States Army as a medic during the Korean conflict and he was of the Methodist faith.
