



## Mr. John Eli Baughman Obituary

Mr. John Eli Baughman, 71, of Albany died Monday July 15, 2013 at Phoebe North Hospital.

A funeral mass will be held Thursday 10:00 AM at St. Teresa's Catholic Church with interment to follow on Friday at Andersonville National Cemetery. Rev. Finbarr Stanton will be officiating.

Born in Clariton, PA, Mr. Baughman was a retired CWO4 with the United States Marine Corp. after 20 years of service. He also retired from the City of Albany inspection department after 20 years. Mr. Baughman was a member of St. Teresa's Catholic Church where he was Communion Minister and Usher. Mr. Baughman was with the Knights of Columbus where he was Past Grand Knight, Past Faithful Navigator, Honor Guard Commander for Andersonville and they got the Family of the Year Award for the State of GA Knights of Columbus. He was also a member of the VFW.

Survivors include his wife Rosemary Baughman of Albany; two sons John Eli Baughman, Jr. of Warner Robins, GA; Eric Joseph Baughman of Albany; a brother Leonard H.
