Mr. John C. Dallas, died Monday, May 21, 2012 at Phoebe North following a short illness.

His funeral service will be Thursday 1 PM at St. Teresa's Catholic Church with interment in Crown Hill Cemetery. Rev. Finbarr Stanton, Rev. Steven Pontzer and Rev. Ben Dallas will officiate.

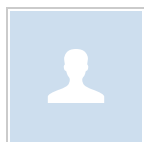
