Mr. John J. Glass, Jr., 2735 Leary Rd, died Thursday, September 13, 2007 at his residence. His funeral service will be Monday 11 AM at Kimbrell-Stern with interment in Crown Hill Cemetery. Rev. Bob Prince and Rev Earl Dean McCorvey officiating. A native of Randolph County, Mr. Glass had lived in Albany for a number of years and was retired from the Department of Labor. He was a member of Raleigh White Baptist Church, Masonic Lodge 591 and the American Legion where he served as Commander. He served in the National Guard for 3 years before enlisting in the U. S. Navy serving for 4 years. He was preceded in death by his parents John and Ruth Glass.
