



John David Herndon, Jr. Obituary

April 27, 1919 - February 14, 2011

Mr. Herndon was born to the late John David Herndon, Sr. and Flonnie Beasley Herndon on April 27, 1919 in Durham, North Carolina. He was a graduate of Lowes Grove High School in Durham and attended North Carolina State University. He was a veteran of World War II having served in both the Army Corps of Engineers in North Africa and Italy and later in the Air Force. After returning home from service, he married Mary Edna Young of Americus, Georgia on March 22, 1946. They moved to Albany that same year. He worked as a surveyor for Marbury Engineering Company until his retirement in 1981. He came out of retirement and worked as a school crossing guard at the corner of Dawson Road and Baldwin Drive for many years until poor health forced him to retire again. Mr. Herndon was a member of First Baptist Church of Albany for over 60 years where he served as a deacon and a youth and nursery Sunday school teacher. He joined First United Methodist Church of Albany in 2007. He was a former member of the Exchange Club of Albany. Mr. Herndon was an avid Atlanta Braves and Georgia Bulldogs fan. He was also a fan of stock car racing having co-owned a stock car many years ago. In its early years, as a supporter of Deerfield School, he helped lay out the first football field. He was preceded in death by his parents; his sister, Jenny Herndon Drew of Americus; and his nephew, Ken Drew of Andersonville. He is survived by his wife of over 64 years, Mary Herndon; his son and daughter-in-law, David and Linda Herndon of High Rolls, New Mexico; his daughter, Becky Herndon of Albany; two

grandchildren, Kathy Herndon Peterson (Todd) of El Paso, Texas and Thomas Herndon (Laura) of Glorieta, New Mexico; and 4 great-grandchildren, Brayden, Maura, Saraya, and Kale.
