



Mr. John Wendall Prince

July 21, 1937 - January 31, 2018

J. Wendall Prince passed away on January 31, 2018 at Magnolia Manor Nursing Home in Americus, GA after a long battle with Alzheimer's disease. The funeral service will be held Saturday, February 3, 2018 at 11:00 AM at Kimbrell-Stern with visitation an hour prior to the service starting at 10:00 AM. A private entombment will be held later. The service will be officiated by Rev. William Collins and Rev. Charles Rhuel.

Mr. Prince was born in Thomas County, GA on July 21, 1937 to John Kendall (J.K.) Prince and Myrtis Jackson Prince. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his daughter Jane P. Nichols Seckinger and his brother K. Willard Prince. He is survived by his wife, Julie Brooks Prince; son, John W. Prince; and three grandsons, Ned (Coy Edwin II) Nichols, Cameron and Johnathan Prince and several nieces and nephews.

Mr. Prince was a General Contractor in Albany, Ga. He and his brother owned J.K. Prince and Sons from 1965 until their retirement. He attended Georgia Southwestern College and the University of Georgia where he was a member of ATO Social Fraternity.

Mr. Prince served in the Army National Guard. He was active in the community serving in many capacities including the Jury Commission and YMCA Board of Directors. He was a member of the Jaycees and was active at the local, state, and national level. Mr. Prince was listed in the 1970 Edition of Outstanding Young Men of America.

He was a member of Porterfield Memorial United Methodist Church, where he

served as a trustee, an usher, worked with the youth program, and was a member of the Key Sunday School Class. Mr. Prince was also a member of Sertoma and Exchange Clubs of Albany.
