John Tony Tsiklistas, 89, of Albany, died Sunday, July 15, 2018 in Cumming, GA.

His funeral service will be at 11 AM on Tuesday, July, 17, 2018 at St. Paul's Episcopal Church with interment to follow at Crown Hill Cemetery. The Rev. Robert O'Laughlin will officiate. The family will receive friends at Kimbrell-Stern on Monday from 6-8 PM with a prayer service at 7 PM.
