



## Mr. Johnnie James Pichelmayer

November 10, 1932 - July 3, 2015

Johnnie James Pichelmayer, age 82, born Nov 10, 1932 Hanceville, AL. He died on Friday, July 3, 2015 in Panama City, FL.

The funeral service for Mr. Pichelmayer will be at 2 PM on Monday, July 6, 2015 at the graveside at Crown Hill Cemetery. The Rev. Greg Davis will officiate.

He is the son of Albert Mathew and Lillie Beth (Clapp) Pichelmayer. He was preceded in death by both parents and his 3 brothers: A.M. Pichelmayer, Jr, Billy Drew Pichelmayer, and Lloyd Warner Pichelmayer.

He was a graduate of Woodlawn High school, Birmingham, AL, where he excelled in football, later going to Auburn University and Florida State University and South Georgia College where he played under Coach Bobby Bowden.

He spent time in the US Army during the Korean War as a physical education trainer for incoming recruits as a member of the Signal Corp at Camp Gordon, Augusta, GA. He was employed with Alabama Gas Company for 32 years and also owned his own accounting business until his late 70s. Mr. Pichelmayer was a member of Five Points King Solomon Lodge No. 897, F&AM Masonic Lodge for 62 yrs. He was a member of the Baptist faith. He lived in Fort Gaines, GA after retirement until recently relocating to Panama City, FL

He has been married for 57 years to Patty Sue Hopkins Pichelmayer. He is survived by his wife Patty; a daughter Bettina Pichelmayer Burnette of Watkinsville, GA; a son Kirk (Robin) Pichelmayer of Panama City, FL; grandchildren: Landon (Trevice) Burnette, Jason (Morgan) Burnette, Amanda Burnette, Mary Burnette, Sam Burnette, Sarah Burnette, John Daniel Burnette, Ali (Craig) Pichelmayer Bennett.
